# 2010 Warm Up Circuit and World Show Premium

## GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

Classes will be conducted and judged in accordance with current IBHA rules. The IBHA World Championship Show is also known as the Dunarama World Show. All horses regardless of age must be registered with the IBHA to compete in the Warm Up or World shows. Be aware that the IBHA office is closed prior to and during the World Week. There is no registration of horses on grounds.

World Show: Late entries will be accepted up until 5 p.m. the day before the class is held.  
Class fee plus late fee as published will be charged.  
Warm Up Circuit: Late entries accepted four classes prior on day of show.

## REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

### ORIGINAL IBHA REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE IS TO BE PRESENTED AT CHECK IN.

Exception: Horses entered in the show and world sale must have original registration certificate sent with sale consignment contract to the IBHA Office and verification will be made for check in on arrival at the show. The management has made every effort to present these shows on the highest level of sportsmanship. Great care has been exercised to select judges with broad experience and knowledge of buckskin horses. The judges' decision in the show ring is their own responsibility and the management accepts no responsibility for their decisions. The management reserves the right to refuse entries or evict anyone from the premises for any reasons not limited to, but including unsportsmanlike behavior, discourtesy or disobedience to the officials of the show. All decisions of the management will be final without recourse of any kind.

Show management and the Agricenter International shall not be responsible for loss or injury to any persons or horses or other personal or tack articles that may be lost or in any way damaged. Exhibitors and guests are required to protect their equipment. Lock your trailers, vehicles and other personal items.

The World Show Committee reserves the right for show or grounds officials to enter stalls or other areas to maintain the safety and welfare of animals and exhibitors at the show.

All horses may be asked to submit to laboratory testing. Any owner or handler refusing will be disqualified. Horses disqualified for positive drug tests will forfeit and return all awards and money and all placings.

**PEE WEE CLASSES** Pee Wee classes are free events for youth at the Warm Up Circuit who are not entered in any performance (riding) classes of the Circuit or World Show. Only IBHA registered horses (NO STALLIONS) may be used for these classes. The horse can be a borrowed horse not owned by the youth, parent or guardian. There is no entry fee for these classes but the youth must be entered at the show office no later than the start of class #50 on the day of the Pee Wee class. Following are the classes offered:

- 1) **LEADLINE** for youth 8 & under (Sunday, August 1). Horse to be properly tacked Western or English with halter and lead rope placed under the bridle. Lead person to be 18 years or older and is to lead the horse as requested at a walk. Entries will be judged and ribbons awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- 2) **WALK-TROT** for youth 10 & under (Tuesday, August 3) who are not entered in any performance or leadline class of the Circuit or World Show. Horse to be properly tacked Western or English and will be asked to walk and trot or jog in both directions and to back up in the line up. Entries will be judged and ribbons awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place.

**VEHICLES** Any vehicle, including golf carts, scooter, etc. ARE NOT ALLOWED in barn aisles or show arena.

**VENDOR INFORMATION** Official vendor information may be obtained from the IBHA Office. Only official vendors that have paid for the privilege or received permission may sell or promote products for sale on the show grounds. Anyone found selling or promoting products to sell will be asked to leave the grounds immediately with no recourse and no refund of any entry or stall fees.

**STALLING INFORMATION** Priority in stalling and stall "with" requests will be given consideration to those paying for a circuit stall by June 26; and entering both the Warm Up Circuit and World Shows. Late entries are not guaranteed stalls or placing near requested exhibitors. After June 26, stalls will be assigned on a first come basis. Youth Teams are automatically stalled together if circuit stalls are purchased and when payment is received by June 26. Non Youth Team horses are not guaranteed stalling with Youth Teams.

Exhibitors are expected to clean their stalls and stall area daily. Shavings can be purchased on grounds. First bedding is furnished. **Aisleways in barn to be kept clear and clean.** No motorized vehicles/bicycles/roller blades, etc. in stall aisles, vendor area.

Damage caused to stalls will be charged back to owner/exhibitor. Anyone using an unassigned stall for grooming or storage or stalling, etc. will be charged a full circuit stall fee for the use of that stall.

Stall decorations or draping must not block any aisle ways and must be fire retardant.

Stall assignments will be posted on the Show Secretary door. Assignments will be by name and with stall assigned. You may contact the Security Guard for assistance in locating stalls after hours. Shavings will be available after office hours.

## HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Must be presented at show office to pick up packet.

30 day current health and 12 month Negative Coggins.

**HORSES** Horses are confined to the barn and arena areas and are not allowed in the camping areas or tied to the outside fences. No horses will be allowed in the public areas, sidewalks, lobbies, rests rooms, etc.

**REFUNDS** Refunds will be given only in the event of the death of a horse that is entered in the Circuit or World Show. The owner must comply with the IBHA rulebook regarding deceased horses in order to be given a refund. There will be no other refunds of any fees for any other reason.

**RETURNED CHECKS** A \$35.00 penalty will be assessed for any returned check issued for the Circuit/World Show. The person whose name and address appears on the check will be notified by US Mail and given ten (10) days to clear the account with certified funds. Any returned checks not made good by pre-entry deadline will also be subject to late fees. Any returned checks submitted prior to the show and not rectified by show time will require cash payment only in order to participate. Returned checks not rectified within ten (10) days of notice will constitute cause for IBHA action as per rules in the current IBHA handbook.

**EQUIPMENT JUDGE** An Equipment Judge will be used by the Show Committee. The Equipment Judge shall inspect all animals upon entry into the arena with respect to equipment, attire and class specifics. The Equipment Judge shall have the authority to disqualify an entrant.

**DISCIPLINE** Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, trainer, groom or rider will disqualify the horse/or exhibitor from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, trainer, groom or rider from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

**DISQUALIFICATION** If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, such person shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. IBHA rules to apply.

**TACK CHANGES** A maximum time period of three minutes after final class call will be allowed for tack changes. All tack changes are to be made in the makeup area. Once the arena gate is closed no contestant shall enter the arena. Tack changes must be pre-scheduled with the paddock master.

**GATE RULE** A one minute rule will be enforced. Once the final call for a class has been given, the gate will be closed in one minute unless a tack change is pre-scheduled and performed in the makeup area. Orders of go may be drawn for all classes. Exhibitors missing their order of draw may be disqualified. No late participants will be accepted and no refunds will be given for missed classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be on the grounds and ready to show on the day of his/her scheduled classes without public notice.

**SPLITTING OF RAIL WORK CLASSES** Classes with 24 to 46 entries, the class will be divided into 2 go-rounds. Classes with 47-69 entries will be divided into 3 go-rounds. Management shall determine which entries for each go-round.

**JUDGES** No one shall approach a judge at any time during the World Week. The Show committee reserves the right to substitute a judge or change scheduled assignments during the Show. In case of a tie in results, the computer will be programmed to designate which judge is the tie breaker and no judge will be aware of such choosing until the tie is broken. No one judge shall be designated as "tie breaker" for more than one class at a time and judges will be rotated to break ties.

**LUNCH BREAKS** Breaks will be taken between classes as listed or announced. It is an exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of the classes and to be ready to show in his or her scheduled classes without public notice.

**ARENA USAGE** The committee reserves the right to change arenas as needed.

**DOGS AND PETS** Pets are allowed in camp area and must be secured by a leash. Any dog found loose will be taken to the show grounds management and retained until a \$100.00 release fee is paid. Owner assumes all liability for pets and agrees to clean up after their pet.

**FIRE AND SAFETY** The use of electric, flame or space heaters is prohibited. Cooking on any heat/flame OR food preparation is not allowed in the barn area. Use of electric cords & appliances are at the liability of the horse owner/ trainer or exhibitor.

**LOADING/UNLOADING HORSES** Loading and unloading of horses will be directed by security.

**PARKING AREA - CAMPING FACILITY** There is a designated parking area for all vehicles on the show grounds. No vehicles motorized or non-motorized including carts, scooters and bicycles, etc., are allowed inside the barns/vendor area or blocking entrance to main doors. Designated fire lanes must be kept clear. Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas will be towed away and subject to recovery of the towing fee from the owner. There is no parking of trailers/campers in the camper hookup area without permit and payment. The show cannot and will not be responsible for reserving specific camping spaces. All electrical/extension cords must meet code. There is no emptying of grey water or other tank contents in the camping areas or on grounds. A Pump Service will be offered at additional fee.

**TIME OUTS/SHOW EQUIPMENT FAILURES** There will be no time out for equipment failure. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/owner to be prepared for each class entered.

**HORSE/EXHIBITOR/CLASS SUBSTITUTION** A horse entered in a particular class may move money from one class to another class for the appropriate late fees per class. Money may not be moved to another horse.

**EXHIBITOR CHANGES** After the horse and exhibitor combination have entered the arena for the first time, the same exhibitor must exhibit that horse in all go rounds/cuts or finals of that particular class.

# 2010 NSBA APPROVED CLASSES

**POSTMARKS AND POSTAL METERS**  
Only postmarks from the US Post Office are acceptable (postal meters are not acceptable) and are used in determining any and all deadlines. Post entries must be postmarked by July 17, 2010. After July 17 entries must be brought to the show office.

**POSTING OF FLYERS-SIGNS, ETC.**  
Flyer sheets may be posted in the barn area but must be removed at the end of the World Show. Signs and flyers are not to be taped to doors or walls of show office nor placed in the paddock area.

**MEMBERSHIPS**  
Open, Amateur or Youth IBHA Memberships can be purchased at the show with appropriate rush fees. NSBA memberships may also be purchased at the show.

**SALE HORSES**  
Should the seller reserve the right to complete the exhibition of a horse on the day after the sale, that seller is responsible for the safety and condition of the horse until the completion of the last class in which the horse is exhibited. In such instance, the buyer is required to pay for the horse on the day of the sale and will assume ownership and responsibility after the horse completes the last class of exhibition. A buyer can only reject the purchase if the horse is injured prior to completion of the last class exhibited at which time the purchase price would be refunded. Should the horse become injured while in the possession of the seller, that seller will maintain ownership of the horse with no recourse to the buyer, the Sale Company or International Buckskin Horse Association and sale commission will apply.

**WORLD SHOW POINT CALCULATIONS**  
Points will be tabulated on the following basis in classes having more than one entry  
1st - 55 2nd - 45 3rd - 36 4th - 28 5th - 21 6th - 15 7th - 10 8th - 6 9th - 3 10th - 1

**RULES FOR WORLD CHAMPION ALL AROUNDS**  
POINTS ARE CALCULATED ON THE OVERALL WORLD PLACING USING THE POINT SYSTEM ABOVE.

**ALL AROUND AMATEUR** award is limited to one horse, one amateur placing. Should an amateur be entered with more than one horse in amateur events, the horse that is shown in amateur showmanship will be the horse used to calculate points toward the amateur all around title.

An amateur must be entered in amateur showmanship and at least one amateur performance class with the same horse to be eligible for points to count toward the all around amateur title.

All amateur events shall count toward the all around amateur title unless a class has only one entry. Classes with only one entry will not be issued points to be used to calculate the all around amateur title. World Champion All Around Amateur and Reserve World Champion All Around Amateur awards will be presented after the world show at the Queen's Ball.

In case of a tie, the same calculations will be used as in the open classes to break such tie. the most world champion amateur title, then the most reserve world champion amateur titles, then the most 3rds, etc. If all else fails, a pre-selected judge's placing in amateur showmanship will prevail to break the tie. All ties will be broken. There will be no co-awards.

**ALL AROUND YOUTH** titles shall be awarded to 14-18 and 13 & Under age divisions. Points are awarded on a one horse, one youth placing. Should a youth be entered on more than one horse for the Youth Activity events, each horse with the same youth will accumulate separate points toward this title.

The youth must be entered in a least one Y.A. Showmanship class and one Performance class to be eligible for points to count toward the All Around Youth title in their age division.

All Youth Activity age appropriate classes shall count toward the All Around Youth 14-18 or 13 & Under title respectively unless a class has only one entry. Classes with only one entry will not be issued points to be used to calculate the All Around titles.

World Champion All Around Youth 14-18 and 13 & Under and Reserve World Champion All Around Youth 14-18 and 13 & Under awards will be presented after the World Show at the Queens Ball.

In case of a tie, the same calculations will be used as in the open classes to break such tie. The most World Champion Youth events, then the most Reserve World Champion Youth events, then the most 3rd places, etc. will be the determining tie breakers. If all else fails, a pre-selected judge's placing Y.A. Western Showmanship will prevail to break the tie. All ties will be broken. There will be no co-awards.

**ALL AROUND HORSE** must be entered in Halter and at least one Performance class to be eligible for points to count toward the All around title.

All open classes entered including Halter, Dun Factor, Western, Hunt Seat and Timed Events shall count toward the All Around title unless such classes have only one entry. Classes with one entry will not be issued points to be used to calculate the All Around title.

Placing of the 3 judge average (World Champion event placing) will determine points earned in each event for the All Around title. World Champion All Around Horse and Reserve World Champion All Around Horse awards will be presented after the World Show at the Queens Ball.

In case of a tie, the horse winning the most World Champion open events will be declared the winner. If a tie still exists, the horse winning the most Reserve World Champion open events will be declared the winner. If a tie still exists the most 3rd places, then 4th places, etc., until a tie is broken and if a dead heat on exact placing exists, a pre-selected judge's placing in halter will prevail to break the tie. All ties will be broken. There will be no co-awards.

## HELD IN CONJUNCTION WITH IBHA WARM-UP CIRCUIT OF SHOWS

NOTE: ALL ENTRY FEES FOR NSBA CLASSES MUST BE PAID IN ADDITION TO THE RESPECTIVE IBHA CLASSES. NSBA CLASSES WILL RUN CONCURRENT WITH IBHA CLASSES.

### RULES:

1. Exhibitors and owners must be current members of NSBA as well as IBHA.
2. NSBA classes are approved only for NSBA points. There is no payback in NSBA classes.
3. IBHA rules will be used for judging. One judge, for one set of NSBA points, will be used for each circuit show. Applicable IBHA rules take precedent over NSBA rules.
4. Only NSBA exhibitors that place on the judge's breed card will be recognized for NSBA points. Points given to those placing will reflect the total number of NSBA entries that participated in the class.
5. Pre Entry fees for NSBA classes are \$15.00 per class per show and are to be sent with circuit show entry by June 26. Post Entry fees after June 26 are \$20.00 per class per show. (Entries after July 17 CANNOT be mailed and must be brought to the show office).
