



IBHA World Championship Show

July 19th-24th, 2026 – C Bar C Expo Center, Cloverdale, Indiana



- PRE-ENTRY - JUNE 9, 2026 - POST ENTRY AFTER JUNE 9, 2026
- Any entry after July 1 must be done in person at the show office and will not be accepted via mail or online.
- Start time is 8:00 am each day of the show, except the first day which will start at 9:00 am.
- NSBA classes available as indicated on the schedule.
- Rail classes with 24-46 entries will be divided into two splits; rail classes with 47-69 entries will be divided into three splits. Management shall determine which entries will exhibit in each split and may change the numbers in each split. The final go will be held after the last split.
- Trail classes may be held in either arena
- The two Versatility classes will be held concurrently
- Two Year Olds shown in Longe Line or In-Hand Trail may not show in any class under saddle.

GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION: Classes will be conducted and judged in accordance with current IBHA rules, which may be found on www.ibha.net/forms. All horses, regardless of age, must be registered with IBHA to compete at the IBHA World Championship Show, including Buckskin-Bred horses. Please be aware that the IBHA office is closed prior to and during the World Show week. There will be an opportunity to register horses on the grounds on Saturday, July 18th ONLY 2:00-6:00PM.

ONLINE ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted ONLINE via www.HorseShowTracker.com beginning May 1st. You are not charged upon submission via The Tracker. You will be charged once the entries are processed by show management. Credit card fees will apply. If you enter via The Tracker, do not mail your entries.

PAPER ENTRIES: any entry being made via paper will mail the entry form & necessary registration papers, cards, etc to the address below. They are not mailed to the IBHA office. Paper forms will be available May 1.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted five classes prior to desired class; if the class is within the first five classes held of the day, late entries must be in by 5 pm the day before. Draws will be done for the following day at 5 pm the night before.

POSTMARKS: For mailed entries, only postmarks from the US Postal Service are acceptable (postal meters are not acceptable) and are used in determining any and all deadlines. Post entries must be postmarked by July 1, 2026; any entries being submitted after July 1 must be brought to the show office.

REQUIRED PAPERWORK: Copies of registration certificates and membership cards for both the owner and exhibitor must be submitted with entry forms.

MUST provide copies with paper entries OR upload via The Tracker. ROM required for those showing performance halter.

THE ORIGINAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE must be presented at the office upon check-in, with the exception being horses registered on the grounds on Saturday, July 18. No back numbers will be provided without original copies shown (\$100 processing fee for those that do not have originals). A health certificate issued within 30 days and a negative Coggins test within 12 months must also be presented upon check-in for ALL horses being exhibited; regardless of location. These health papers must contain the REGISTERED name of each horse.

MEMBERSHIP: Open, Amateur, Amateur Select, Youth, or Adult Walk-Trot IBHA memberships can be purchased at the show with the appropriate rush fees. NSBA memberships/licenses may also be purchased at the show. Owners and Exhibitors must be a current member of IBHA to participate.

AWARD PRESENTATION: after the judging of all classes, the entries/finalists will be retired to the rail. Each judge's card will be read and the exhibitors shall come off of the rail.

CONDUCT POLICY: Management has made every effort to present this show on the highest level of sportsmanship. Great care has been exercised to select judges with experience & broad knowledge of the IBHA breed. The judges' decisions in the show ring are final & show management accepts no responsibility for their decisions. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries or evict anyone from the premises for any reasons, not limited to, but including: unsportsmanlike conduct, discourtesy or disobedience to show officials. All decisions of show management will be final without recourse of any kind.

AWARD BANQUET: all high point awards will be presented at the banquet. If unable to attend, you may designate someone to accept the award on your behalf. However, no awards will be mailed.

LIABILITY WAIVER: Show management & the C Bar C Expo Center shall not be responsible for any loss or injury to any persons or horses or other personal or tack articles that may be lost in or damaged in any way. Exhibitors and guests are expected to protect their equipment. Please lock your trailers, vehicles, and other personal items.

SAFETY: Show management reserves the right for show or grounds officials to enter stalls or other areas to maintain the safety and welfare of animals and exhibitors at the show. Horses are to be confined to the barn and arena areas and are not allowed in the camping areas or tied to outside fences. Horses will not be allowed in public areas, sidewalks, lobbies, restrooms, etc. The use of electric, flame, or space heaters is prohibited. Cooking on any heat/flame or food preparation is not allowed in the barn area. Use of electric cords and appliances are at the liability of the horse owner, trainer, or exhibitor.

VEHICLE POLICY: Motorized vehicles, including golf carts, scooters, etc, hoverboards, rollerblades, etc. are not allowed in the BUILDING. No exceptions except facility-owned vehicles.

DRUG TESTING POLICY: All horses may be asked to submit to laboratory testing. Any owner or handler refusing will be disqualified. Horses disqualified for positive drug tests will forfeit and return all awards, money, and placings.

VENDOR INFORMATION: Official vendor information may be obtained from Denise Kurtz with the IBHA office. Only vendors that have paid for the privilege or received permission may sell or promote products for sale on the grounds. Anyone found selling or promoting products to sell without permission will be asked to leave the grounds immediately with no recourse and no refund of any entry or stall fees.

FLYER POLICY: Flyers may be posted in the barn area but must be removed at the end of the show. Signs and flyers are not to be taped to doors or walls of the show office, nor placed in the paddock area.

PERFORMANCE HALTER – if showing this class, be prepared to show proof of an ROM earned in Open classes.

STALLING INFORMATION: Priority in stalling requests will be given consideration to those paying for a stall by July 1st. After July 1st, stalls will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. Late entries are not guaranteed stalls. Youth Teams are automatically stalled together if payment is received by July 1st. Non-Youth

Team horses from the same group are not guaranteed to be stalled with Youth Teams. Please designate which stalls are to be included in team stalling area. This includes hospitality stalls. Exhibitors are expected to clean their stalls and stall areas daily; aisles are to be kept clean and clear. Shavings must be purchased on the grounds from C Bar C staff; NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS. Damage caused to stalls will be charged back to the horse owner / exhibitor. Anyone using an unassigned stall for grooming, storage, stalling, etc. will be charged the full stall fee for use of that stall. Stall decorations or draping must not block any aisles and must be fire retardant. Stall assignments will be posted and available from C Bar C personnel, and assistance is available after office hours as well. Stalls are required; no showing off of the trailers. One horse per stall with the exception of mini horses. Those horses are limited to two horses per stall.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds will only be given in the event of the death of a horse entered in the World Championship Show. The owner must comply with the IBHA rulebook regarding deceased horses in order to be given a refund. There will be no other refunds of any fees for any other reason.

RETURNED CHECK POLICY: A \$35 penalty will be assessed for any returned check issued at the show. The person whose name and address appears on the check will be notified by US Mail and given 10 days to clear the account with certified funds. Any returned checks not made good by pre-entry deadline will also be subject to late fees. Any returned checks submitted prior to the show and not rectified by show time will require cash payment only in order to participate. Returned checks not rectified within 10 days of notice will constitute cause for IBHA action as per rules in the current IBHA rulebook.

CREDIT CARDS: Cards will be charged a 4% service fee.

EQUIPMENT JUDGE: An Equipment Judge will be used by the show committee, and shall inspect all animals upon entry into the arena with respect to equipment, attire, and class specifics. The Equipment Judge shall have the authority to disqualify an entrant.

DISCIPLINE: Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, trainer, groom, or exhibitor, will disqualify the horse and/or exhibitor from adjudication. Show management reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, trainer, groom, or exhibitor from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

DISQUALIFICATION: If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made any false statement regarding any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, such person shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting; IBHA rules to apply.

TACK CHANGES: A maximum time period of three minutes after the final class call will be allowed for tack changes. All tack changes are to be made in the makeup arena. Once the arena gate is closed, no contestant shall enter the arena. Tack changes must be pre-scheduled with the paddock master.

GATE RULE: Once the final call for a class has been given, the gate will be closed in one minute unless a tack change is pre-scheduled and performed in the makeup arena. Orders of go may be drawn for all classes. Exhibitors missing their order of draw may be disqualified. No late participants will be accepted & no refunds will be given for missed classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be on the grounds & ready to show on the day of his or her scheduled classes without public notice.

JUDGES: No one shall approach a judge at any time during the week of the World Championship Show. The show committee reserves the right to substitute a judge or change scheduled assignments during the show. In the event of a tie, the computer will be programmed to designate which judge is the tiebreaker judge, and no judge will be aware of such choosing until the tie is broken. No one judge shall be designated as the tiebreaker judge for more than one class at a time and judges will be rotated to break ties.

BREAKS: Breaks will be taken between classes as listed on the showbill or as announced. It is an exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of the classes and be ready to show in their scheduled classes without public notice.

ARENA USAGE: Show management reserves the right to change arenas as needed.

PET POLICY: Pets are allowed in the camping area and must be secured by a leash. Any dog found loose will be taken to the show grounds management and retained until a \$100 release fee is paid. Pet owners assume all liability for pets and agree to clean up after their pet. No dogs are allowed in any arena.

PARKING & CAMPING: There is a designated parking area for all vehicles on the show grounds. No vehicles, motorized or non-motorized (including carts, scooters, bicycles, etc.) are allowed inside the barn and vendor area or blocking the entrance to main doors. Designated fire lanes must be kept clear. Vehicles parking in unauthorized areas will be towed and subject to recovery of the towing fee from the owner. There is no parking of trailers and campers in the camping area without permit and payment. The show cannot and will not be responsible for reserving specific camping spaces. All electrical / extension cords must meet code. There is no emptying of grey water or other tank contents in the camping areas or on the grounds. A pump service may be offered at an additional fee. All empty trailers will be moved to the lot to the east of the property.

EQUIPMENT FAILURE: There will be no time-outs granted for equipment failure. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be prepared for each class entered.

SUBSTITUTION: A horse entered in a particular class may move money from one class to another class for the appropriate late fees per class. Money may not be moved to another horse. After a horse and rider combination has entered the arena for the first time, that same exhibitor must show the horse in all splits and final go of that particular class.

TRAIL SCHOOLING: Each horse entered in a trail class will be charged \$10.00 per horse (not per class) for trail schooling. You may school as long as you wish when the course is available.

INDIVIDUAL CLASS CALCULATIONS – the various classes will use the following point calculations: 1st = 120, 2nd = 102, 3rd = 91, 4th = 78, 5th = 66, 6th = 55, 7th = 45, 8th = 36, 9th = 28, 10th = 21. All five (5) judges' placings will count towards calculations.

SCORED CLASSES: All Classes that are scored, will be converted to ranked and then the final composite results will be based off of rankings.

ALL-AROUND POINT CALCULATIONS: 1st = 120, 2nd = 102, 3rd = 91, 4th = 78, 5th = 66, 6th = 55, 7th = 45, 8th = 36, 9th = 28, 10th = 21. – composite placings.

ALL-AROUND AWARD RULES

- All-Around for Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18, Youth Walk-Trot, Amateur, Amateur Select, and Adult Walk-Trot is limited to one horse, one exhibitor placing. Should an exhibitor be entered with more than one horse in their respective division events, the horse that is shown in showmanship will be the horse used to calculate points for the all-around title. An exhibitor must enter and show in their respective Showmanship and at least one performance class in that same division with the same horse to be eligible for the All-Around title. All division events shall count toward the All-Around title. Halter required in 13 & under, 14-18 & Amateur.
- All-Around Ranch Horse must enter and show in Ranch Conformation and at least one Ranch performance class in EACH DIVISION to be eligible for points for the All-Around title. Awards will be given in Open, Amateur & Youth.

- All-Around Open Horse must enter and show in Halter and at least one performance class to be eligible for points for the All-Around title. All open classes entered including Halter, Dun Factor, Western, Hunt Seat, and Timed Events shall count toward the All-Around title. In-hand classes will not count towards the Open Horse.
- Buckskin Bred Horse must enter & show in Halter and at least one performance class to be eligible for points for the All-Around Buckskin-Bred title.
- All-Around Miniature Horse must show in Halter and at least one Miniature Performance class.
- A High Point Yearling Award will be presented – halter & one in-hand class must be shown. Dun Factor will count towards total.
- A High Point 2-year-old Award will be presented – a halter class & one in-hand class will be required. Dun Factor will count towards total.
- Placing of the 5 judge average (World Champion event placing) will determine points earned in each event for the All-Around title.
- World Champion and Reserve Champion All-Around awards will be presented at the Queen's Ball.
- In the case of a tie, the horse winning the most World Champion events in their respective division will be declared the winner. If a tie still exists, the horse winning the most Reserve World Champion events will be declared the winner. If a tie still exists, the most 3rd places, then 4th, etc. until a tie is broken. If a dead heat on exact placings exists, a pre-selected judge's placing in halter will prevail to break the tie. All ties will be broken, there will be no co-awards.
- High Point NSBA horse will be presented to the highest point earning horse showing in NSBA classes. Tabulated in all classes, regardless of exhibitor with same owner.

RICHARD KURZEJA YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP VERSATILITY TOURNAMENT

The Scholarship Versatility Tournament will be held on Wednesday, July 24th in conjunction with the Versatility Sweepstakes class.

1ST Place: \$1,000 Scholarship

2nd Place: \$500 Scholarship

Tournament Rules

- Entrant must be an IBHA member and have participated in IBHA for two years prior to entering the tournament.
- Student is to be enrolled and accepted for the 2026 fall semester in an accredited college, university, business college, or trade school.
- Proof of fall enrollment must accompany entry form.
- Application must be mailed, with a copy sent to the IBHA office, by July 1, 2026 – NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Judging will be done on the same horse/rider combination in all four classes.
- Entrant may use a borrowed IBHA-registered horse.
- Classes for the Versatility Tournament shall include:
 - Showmanship – may be in Western or English tack and attire
 - Trail – may be in Western or English tack and attire
 - Pleasure – may be Western or English tack & attire
 - Barrel Racing – placed by electronic timer plus faults
- There are no entry fees for the tournament and only 1st and 2nd place winners of the aggregated average of scoring will receive scholarship awards.
- The tournament is sponsored by the IBHA Youth Scholarship Fund to expand the scholarship program and to aid in furthering the education of IBHA students.
- Forms are available from charter delegates or from the IBHA office.

NSBA DUAL-APPROVED CLASSES

*All entry fees for NSBA classes must be paid in addition to the respective IBHA class entry fee. Held concurrently with their respective IBHA classes

- Exhibitors and owners must be current members of NSBA as well as IBHA. Copies of membership cards must be submitted with entries.
- All horses must be NSBA registered. Copies of both IBHA and NSBA registration certificates must be submitted with entries. Licenses can be purchased in the show office.
- NSBA classes are approved only for NSBA points with no payback for the classes.
- IBHA rules will be used for judging. Each of the judges will judge separately and cumulative World Show placings will apply. Applicable IBHA rules take precedence over NSBA rules.
- Only NSBA exhibitors who place on the judges' breed cards will be recognized for NSBA points. Points given to those placing will reflect the total number of NSBA entries that participated in the class. NSBA Champion determined by composite scores/placings of all judges.
- NSBA trophies will be presented to those NSBA classes marked with NSBA (T). Those NSBA classes marked with NSBA (P) will be presented with a plaque. Regardless of the number of entries.

ADDED MONEY CLASSES

For all added money classes, each horse must be IBHA or IBHA Buckskin-bred registered. All owners & exhibitors must be current IBHA members. Each class will feature all 5 World Show judges and no IBHA points or year-end awards will be presented. Individual scores/results will be posted & all results will be considered final. World show rules apply regarding refunds. Composite placing ribbons will be awarded. All payback will be figured at 100% of the added money plus 80% of the entry fee.

Green Western Pleasure: Horses entered in this class cannot have earned an ROM in ANY riding class prior to 1-1-26.

Green Hunter Under Saddle: Horses entered in this class cannot have earned an ROM in ANY riding class prior to 1-1-26.

Ideal Ranch Horse: Horses will enter the arena on the rail, showing Ranch Pleasure. At the completion of the judging the riders will line up in the middle of the arena. The exhibitors will then unsaddle their horses, placing their equipment in front of them with their pad on the saddle showing their numbers.

Exhibitors will then set up their horse to show conformation to the judges. At the completion the exhibitors will then re-saddle their horses and may remount to wait for the placings. This class will be judged 50% Ranch Pleasure and 50% Conformation. The overall composite results will be announced.

Yearling Non-Pro Longe Line – all exhibitors must be non-pro and meet non-pro ownership rules. Must complete Non Pro Form on IBHA.net

Versatility - This class consists of same horse/same rider competing in Showmanship, Pleasure, Trail and Barrel Racing. Run concurrently with the Youth Scholarship Versatility Class.

Freestyle Reining - This class will follow the NRHA rules on freestyle reining. See the IBHA website at www.ibha.net for full rules.

Dun Factor- Open to registered IBHA Regular & Miniature Horses. Places will be taken from the Dun Factor & Miniature Dun Factor classes on the integrated placings of these 2 classes and will be announced after the Miniature class is placed. This is not a separate class, but you do need to enter the added money class that is class 807 to be eligible for the added money.
